

2025 RAS Membership Renewal Form - Online payers

The Byelaws of the Royal Astronomical Society (approved May 2023) set out the privileges and obligations of being a Fellow. By becoming or continuing to be a member of the Society you are bound to the Code of Conduct for Members and the Universal Ethical Code of Scientists. Both of these can be found on our website: www.ras.ac.uk.

You have opted to pay your RAS membership fee online. Please log into the Fellows' of the RAS website to pay: https://fellows.ras.ac.uk/. Once logged in, go to 'My Details'-> 'My Memberships'-> and click the 'Membership(s)' payment button.

Please note that we no longer accept payments by cheque.

If you have a UK bank account and would like to pay by direct debit you can set this up online. Once logged into the Fellows' of the RAS website, go to 'My Details'-> 'My Memberships'-> and click the 'Membership(s)' payment button and the option to set up a direct debit is available. The deadline date to set up a direct debit is 20 December 2024.

Membership Fees for 2025

Rate 3: Fellows who completed full-time education before 1st January 2020 £161.00

Rate 2(a): Early career researcher Fellows: Fellows who ceased to be eligible for rate 1 having completed their full-time education **after** 1st January 2025 and are in the early stages of a career in astronomy, geophysics, or a related subject; £108.00

Rate 2(b): Early career researcher Fellows: Fellows who *were* registered full-time students in 2024 but are *not* students in 2025 £72.00

Rate 1: Fellows who, on 1 January **2025** are undergraduate or postgraduate students studying astronomy, geophysics or a related subject, at a rate equivalent to at least 25% of full-time study. Fellows may only apply for this rate for up to 9 years; **£31.00**

Students

If you are a student on 1 January **2025** then to be eligible for the reduced rate you will need to provide proof of your student status. Please complete the student declaration on page 4 or provide a recent headed letter/acceptance letter from your institution or a screen grab of your student portal. The proof must confirm the subject you are studying and whether it is at least 25% of full-time study.

1. The rates for *non-student* Fellows who are members of the Institute of Physics (IOP) are abated by 25%:

Rate 3: £121.00 Rate 2a: £81.00 Rate 2b: £54.00

- 2. Fellows on *rate* 3 and who are also members of the Geological Society London (GSL) can claim a 25% discount.
- 3. Fellows aged 65 or over, who are also of at least 15 years standing, may request to pay a concessionary rate of £31. Please contact the Membership Officer at membership@ras.ac.uk.
- 4. Fellows who, before 2003, exercised their rights under bye-law 39 are exempt from paying.
